Please bring the following materials to the course:

- Beginning and progress records of a patient that preferably has an overjet and interarch discrepancy, and that you believe is within 6 months of being completed.
 - the extraoral and intraoral photos and the orthopantomogramm are to be on Power Point (Version 2003 or lower).
 - mounted study casts are preferred
 - bring beginning and progress headfilm with beginning and progress tracings.
- Diagnostic template, acetate paper, red, green and black pencils, tape.
- 2 Angle wire-bending pliers, or the pliers you use for torquing rectangular archwires.
- 6 Rectangular archwires of the size you normally use to finish treatment
- **Comfortable shoes: if the weather favours it we can hike to the top of the Schöckel (approx. 1 ¼ hour) on Saturday after course work; alternatively we can take the cable car ☺**
